

When A Righteous Man
Turns Away
Ezekiel 18:24-26



This whole sermon by Ezekiel is about personal responsibility and accountability for personal sins.

Israel's adaptation of a pagan proverb is to be rejected and spoken no more.

There are 5 scenarios in this sermon which speak to the personal responsibility for one's life before God.

Truth-1- Previous righteous actions will not cancel out subsequent unrighteousness.

Truth-2- Turning from righteousness to wickedness makes one guilty of unfaithfulness and a sinner.

Truth-3- The ultimate reality for turning away is death—and that is just!

Truth-4- So long as one lives, God extends the chance to turn back to Him again!

***Every person who has turned from
God needs to hear God's appeal—
"Repent and live." (v.32)***
