REMEMBER: TWO SIMPLE and BASIC RULES FOR HANDLING THE SCRIPTURES RIGHTLY:

1—Be sure you know the context of both subject and time for any Scripture you are going to apply!

2-On any given subject, The Bible can never mean <u>LESS</u> than what is stated in a verse, but it can always mean <u>MORE</u> when comparing it to other verses on the subject!

OK, so let's tackle another of these challenging passages. Next—ACCEPTING CHRIST Two key questions are:

- 1- Does the Bible use the phrase?
- 2- If so, how does one accept a <u>PERSON</u>?

1—YOU MUST ACCEPT WHAT HE OFFERS YOU!

- John 1:10-13
- If you refuse His gift, you refuse HIM!

2–YOU MUST ACCEPT THE AUTHORITY ON WHICH HE COMES

John 5:41-44

3–YOU MUST ACCEPT THE MESSAGE HE COMMUNICATES TO YOU

- Reject His Person, You Obviously Reject His message!
- Reject His message and you have rejected HIM!

OK, so what about the believer... the person already born again? The Bible has a word for us as well on the subject... Colossians 2:6-7
