No picture is more endearing to us than a good shepherd watching over his sheep.

The whole metaphor of shepherds and sheep is about RELATIONSHIPS.

Why is Psalm 23 such a treasured passage of Scripture?



Consider the GOOD shepherd:

- 1– He knows his sheep. (v.3-5)
- 2– He IS THE door. (v.9)
- 3– He is all about LIFE and protections (v.10-16)
- 4– He makes the ultimate sacrifice for His lambs. (v.17-18)

Given all this, it should come as no surprise that God called shepherds to be the first nativity guest when Jesus came into the world.
