Psalm 143:1-12 (v.8 & 10)

The availability of God's guidance is a most comforting thought, particularly given all the options one has before him.



The Hebrew word for guidance is "tachbulah" which refers to "rope-pulling" One thing about choosing to live as a Christian is that life is not random, nor is it given to happenstance. It has meaning and purpose and usefulness when the best path is taken. But there's the catch—figuring out the best path. Ps. 143:8!

- 1— I need to acknowledge my need for guidance. That requires humility!
- 2— I need to go to the most trusted source of guidance. And that requires spiritual insight!
- 3— I need clarity between the OK, the better and the best. And that requires discernment.
- 4— I need to know what will do more to keep me on the road to heaven. And that requires spiritual priorities.
- 5— I need to have spiritual power to follow through. And that requires His "good Spirit"
