**Do all you can to meet the life needs of others. (10:30-37 & 12:33-34)**

**Get on Jesus' side and stay there. (11:23 & 19:1-10)  
(Even if you have to climb a sycamore tree.)**

**Avoid doing your Christianity just for show! (11:37-54)**

**Put first things first and the first thing is the kingdom. (12:31 & 9:57-62 & 14:28, 31)**
